BEAVER CAMP

COST: \$400 + HST + FEES

AGES 5 TO 7 YRS

- Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Tues. Jul 9**
- Week 2 – Sat. Jul 13 to Tues. Jul 16**
- Week 3 – Sat. Jul 20 to Tues. Jul 23**
- Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Tues. Jul 30**



- Enjoy 3-nights at camp with includes basic outdoor skills with hikes, aquatic games, and focus on sharing.
- This introductory camping program is for youth who have little or no camping experience either with their parents or Beaver Scouts.

CUBFIELD CAMPS

TENDERPAD CAMP - COST: \$480 + HST + FEES AGES 7 TO 9 YRS

- Week 1 – Tues. Jul 9 to Sat. July 13**
- Week 2 – Tues. Jul 16 to Sat. Jul 20**
- Week 3 – Tues. Jul 23 to Sat. Jul 27**
- Week 4 – Tues. Jul 30 to Sat. Aug 3**

- Enjoy 4-nights at camp which include basic outdoor skills, hikes, games and campfires!
- Ideal for **first time** campers to gain camping and outdoor skills development with little prior camping experience.

GOLD PACK CAMP - COST: \$780 + HST + FEES AGES 7 TO 9 YRS

- Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 13**
- Week 2 – Sat. Jul 13 to Sat. Jul 20**
- Week 3 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Jul 27**
- Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Sat. Aug 3**

- For our youngest Cubs ready to spend a full week of camp.
- Ideal for our youngest Cubs to gain camping and outdoor skills development with little prior camping experience.
- Campers experience an overnight at a satellite site.

RED PACK CAMP - COST: \$780 + HST + FEES AGES 8 TO 9 YRS

- Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 13**
- Week 2 – Sat. Jul 13 to Sat. Jul 20**
- Week 3 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Jul 27**
- Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Sat. Aug 3**

- Red Pack provides your youth with opportunities to use a range of outdoor skills such as swimming, archery, nature discovery, and boating.
- Campers get to spend 1 night out of main camp at our site on O'Brien Lake.

BLACK PACK CAMP - COST: \$780 + HST + FEES AGES 9 TO 10 YRS

- Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 13**
- Week 2 – Sat. Jul 13 to Sat. Jul 20**
- Week 3 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Jul 27**
- Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Sat. Aug 3**

- Black Pack will provide more advanced skills opportunities for the older, more experienced campers. In Black Pack, your youth will have opportunities to lead and work together using a range of outdoor skills and activities such as swimming, archery, nature discovery, and boating.
- Campers experience an overnight sleep-over at a satellite site.

TOTAL PACK CAMP - COST: \$780 + HST + FEES AGES 8 TO 10 YRS

- Week 5 – Sat. Aug 3 to Sat. Aug 10**

- Total Pack provides your youth with opportunities to lead and work together using a range of outdoor skills and activities such as swimming, archery, nature discovery, boating as it relates to the abilities of their pack level.
- Total Pack Camp combines Black Pack and Red Pack so that the older Cubs can help and lead the younger Cubs.
- Campers get to experience an overnight sleep-over at one of our satellite sites.





BROWNSEA CAMP

COST \$820 + HST + FEES

AGES 11 TO 12 YRS

- Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 13**
- Week 2 – Sat. Jul 13 to Sat. Jul 20**
- Week 3 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Jul 27**
- Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Sat. Aug 3**
- Week 5 – Sat. Aug 3 to Sat. Aug 10**



- Brownsea Camp is the Intermediate program between Cubs and Troop.
- Youth are provided with the building blocks to enjoy camping and develop outdoor skills through hands-on activities such as canoeing, hiking and high ropes. Vertical Skills adventures, a regatta, and special all-camp evening activities fill the week.
- Youth take a 2-night canoe trip on Christie Lake and Farren's Lake to develop land and water adventure skills.
- Outdoor Adventure Skills youth may achieve: Paddling, Aquatics, Trail, Camping, and Vertical.

- Outdoor Adventure Skills youth may achieve: Trail and Camping.

- Camp applies all the development of the Troop program with a focus on Paddling Skills.
- Other camp based activities are included during the week; swimming, ropes, and teambuilding.
- A 2-night canoe trip on nearby lakes and rivers.
- Outdoor Adventure Skills youth may achieve: Camping and Paddling.

EXTREME ADVENTURE CAMPS

SURVIVAL CAMP – COST: \$820 + HST + FEES

AGES 13 TO 15 YRS

OUTDOOR SKILLS AND LEADERSHIP (OSL)

COST: \$1,100 + HST + FEES

AGES 14 TO 15 YRS

Week 5 – Sat. Aug 3 to Sat. Aug 10

Week 1&2 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 20

Week 3&4 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Aug 3

- Camp applies all the development of the Troop Program with a focus on Survival Skills.
- Will spend majority of their time staying at our satellite site at Farren's Lake.
- Campers will get the chance to create and sleep in their own shelter.

- OSL is a challenging 2-week leadership development program that concentrates on refining outdoor skills.
- Week 1 is devoted to land-based skills such as backpacking and light-weight camping and includes a 3-night hiking trip.
- Week 2 shifts to water-based skills such as portaging and canoe safety and includes a 3-night canoe trip.
- The 2 weeks are tied together with an overnight survival night challenge.
- Outdoor Adventure Skills youth may achieve: Paddling, Trail, Camping, Emergency.

VERTICAL SKILLS - COST: \$820 + HST + FEES

AGES 13 TO 15 YRS

Week 1 – Sat. Jul 6 to Sat. Jul 13

Week 4 – Sat. Jul 27 to Sat. Aug 3

- Youth spend the first part of the week climbing McManus Rock to fine-tune their climbing skills
- Head off-site to Kingston Mills for a multi-night climbing experience.
- No previous rock climbing experience required!
- Outdoor Adventure Skills youth may achieve: Vertical Skills, Camping

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT)

COST: \$900 + HST + FEES

AGES 15 TO 16 YRS

Week 1&2 – Sat. Jul 8 to Sat. Jul 20

Week 2&3 – Sat. Jul 13 to Sat. Jul 27

Week 3&4 – Sat. Jul 20 to Sat. Aug 3

- The 2-week program provides training to youth interested in obtaining Camp Counselor positions in future years or in enhancing leadership skills.
- Week one activities concentrate on development of team building skills, proper methods of discipline, conflict resolution, personal goal setting, and intensive leadership training.
- Week two involves placement in an appropriate program or service area to apply new-found knowledge.
- CIT builds confidence, prepares youth for an amazing experience as a camp counselor or in their future workforce.

Registration Details:

1. Registration:

Everyone is Welcome – Non-Scouting Members are welcome to experience residential camping at Camp Opemikon.

- a. **An additional \$25.00 is to be added to the camping fee to cover administration costs for Non-Scouting Members.**
This fee must be paid if your child is not a currently registered member of Scouts Canada and we reserve the right to collect this fee upon verification through Scouts Canada's database.

- b. **Fees** are listed beside each camp and online

- i. **Early Bird Discount:** An Early Bird discount of \$25.00 per registration will be available for any registrations made before April 1, 2024

2. Refunds:

- a. Request to cancel or transfer with more than 4 weeks' notice: 80% of payment will be refunded or 100% transferred to another week of camp.
- b. Request to cancel with less than 4 week's notice but more than 2 weeks' notice: 50% of the total payment is refundable.
- c. Request to cancel registrations with less than 2 weeks' notice: No refunds will be issued.
- d. Should Scouts Canada be required to cancel any registration due to extenuating circumstances: We will transfer 100% payment to another week at camp or refund 92% of total payments received.

3. Ages:

- a. Campers must turn the age listed for each program by December 31, 2024.

4. Transportation will be provided at no extra cost from Scouts Headquarters at 1345 Baseline in Ottawa.

- a. You must indicate during registration if transportation is required.
- b. Full details are listed in the Parent/Camper Information package.
